



## **Travel after 29th March 2019**

HM Passport Office have asked us to inform all customers of potential passport validity changes. They have advised that *in the event* of a no-deal Brexit, all people planning to travel abroad after the end of March will be required to have six months left on their passport from the date of travel.

The rules for travel to most countries in Europe will change if the UK leaves the European Union (EU) with no deal. The government has increased planning for a no deal EU Exit and is asking citizens to make sure they are also prepared. UK passport holders should therefore check their passport to see whether it is valid for travel after 29 March 2019.
